BVAL Football Jamboree Outline

The BVAL Jamboree will be held on either Friday, August 29th or Saturday, August 30th as outlined below.

The sites for 2014 will be as follows:

- **Del Mar** – 8/29 – Leigh & Willow Glen, Lincoln & Westmont, Del Mar & Prospect
- **Gunderson** – 8/29– Oak Grove & Santa Teresa, Gunderson & San Jose High, Yerba Buena & Andrew Hill
- **James Lick** – 8/29 – Independence & Piedmont Hills, Evergreen Valley & Silver Creek, James Lick & Overfelt
- **Leland** – 8/30 – Leland & Pioneer, Live Oak & Sobrato, Branham & Mt. Pleasant –
 - **F/S games to begin @ 4:30 PM**
 - *Adjustments will be made to balance the sites if necessary*
 - *Teams were assigned to the closest host site whenever possible, however, we try to schedule 2 MH, 2 ST, & 2 WV teams at each site*

General Format:

- Friday Jamborees will begin at **5:00 PM** sharp – Saturday Jamboree will begin at **1:00 PM**
- “Quarters” will consist of a **20-minute running clock**; there will be no time outs
- A coin flip will determine first possession - The winner can choose Offense or Defense first
- The first offensive series will begin on the 40-yard line, going in. (There will be two games going on simultaneously, heading opposite directions.)
 - ***An Offensive possession ends with any of the following:***
 - A Touchdown (no PATs will be attempted)
 - A Field Goal
 - An interception or lost fumble (quick whistle, no returns by Defense)
 - A turnover on downs
- At the end of an Offensive possession, the Defensive team takes over at the 40 yard line
- Coaches may be on the field, but **all players not involved in the play must be on the sidelines**
 - *Offensive coaches may be in the huddle, then must retreat to at least 10 yds behind the LOS*
 - *Defensive coaches may be in the huddle, then must retreat to the sideline, end zone (if ball is outside the 20) or behind the end line (if ball is inside the 20)*
- There will be a 5-minute transition period between “quarters”
- The Frosh/Soph will follow the same format and schedule and playing **15-minute “quarters”**.
- Each site will provide warm up areas for the teams. Some teams may warm up in the stadium and others outside of the stadium. Any teams with 1st round byes, should warm up on outside fields.

Hosting Guidelines:

Host schools will be required to provide the following personnel:

- 1 Site Director
- Athletic Trainer for game coverage for both F/S and Varsity Jamborees (not to exceed \$200 per site)
- 1-2 ADULT ticket sellers (2-4 volunteers needed for up to 6 hours)
- 1-2 ADULT ticket takers (2-4 volunteers needed for up to 6 hours)
- Police coverage (no more than two (2) per site)
- Custodial coverage as required by your site (1 custodian, max 4 hours)
- Volunteers for 2 Chain Crews for both Jamborees

The BVAL will provide invoices for the site director, police and custodian and will send them checks directly. The site director will be in charge of getting invoices filled out correctly and remitted to the BVAL by September 1st.

In addition to personnel, each site should provide the following:

- Start up cash-box (as you would for a regular home football game)
- 2 sets of chains (you may need to arrange with one of the other participants to bring a 2nd set of chains and Another down marker)
- The field should be fully lined with yard markers and pylons set up, water jugs for the benches (or a place for teams to fill up their containers)
- The scoreboard should be operational for timing purposes. Announcers are not needed, unless you want To plug your snack shack and use the PA to help with transitioning between “quarters”.
- Food Concession, which host school gets 100% of profit

An official “BVAL Football Jamboree Host Site Packet” will be made up with all forms, pay rates, duties and responsibilities of hosting school included and given to the host school athletic director. The host site-director will be in charge of collecting money, all record keeping and with turning the proceeds and invoices in to the BVAL office by September 1st.

Matt Kiesle, through PSI’s Kenny Jackson, has secured officials. They will use this opportunity for training their newer referees, etc. This provides a service for our referee association and defers the cost of officials.

Opting Out:

Schools who have opted out of the Jamboree will not receive any of the funds/benefits that the League differs or discounts to their League dues for the following school year.

The BVAL Board of Managers has approved the Jamboree format.
