CIF MODEL COACH

Goal: To recognize coaches who are positive role models within our schools and community.

Criteria: A model coach must have demonstrated and taught the six core ethical values; trustworthiness, respect, responsibility, fairness, caring and good citizenship (the “Six Pillars of Character”). The highest potential of sports is achieved when coaches consciously Teach, Enforce, Advocate and Model (T.E.A.M) these values and are committed to the ideal of Pursuing Victory with Honor. They also, must have a minimum of 10 years of active coaching at the high school level.

Award Process: Each CIF member school can nominate a maximum of one male and one female coach who best reflect the values of Pursuing Victory with Honor. Nominations must be returned to the State CIF office by December 1 (from section office.) *Late nominations will not be read.* In the nomination process, please include no less than two letters of support for the nominated coaches. These shall include specific exemplary sportsmanship and behavior/actions on and off the playing field. These letters are to be no longer than *one page* long. The below nomination form must be signed by the Principal and included with the letters.

◇ Due Date for Nominations is Thursday, December 1, (from Section office.)

◇ Include no less than two letters of support citing specific exemplary behavior/actions which demonstrate the virtues of Pursuing Victory with Honor for the nominated coach.

CCS-CIF MODEL COACH AWARD

Selection Process

1. Who is eligible for nomination?

- Up to two [2] female and two [2] male Coaches, currently certified by member-schools in the CIF-Central Coast Section, from each League.

2. What is the process for nomination and selection?

- The CCS Office will provide four [4] **CIF Model Coach Nomination Forms** (two [2] each for female and male) to each League Commissioner in the CIF-Central Coast Section.
- Leagues are requested to establish their own procedures for selecting their respective nominees.
- Upon establishing and completing their respective selection procedures, Leagues are requested to ensure completion and return of the appropriate **Nomination Forms**, including all appropriate Principals' signatures, along with up to two [2] letters of support for the nominated Coach(es), to the CCS Office, by **November 15th**.
- During the third week of November, ballot packets (including submitted nominations, letters of support, and copies of the CIF "Pursuing Victory With Honor" **Expectations for Coaches** and the **CIF Code of Conduct for Interscholastic Coaches**) will be mailed to all current members of the CCS Athletic Directors Advisory Committee.
- The ADAC members will jointly cast their votes for one [1] female and one [1] male **Model Coach** by returning their ballots to the CCS Office by no later than **December 1st**. Simple majority of all votes cast will decide whose names will be forwarded on to the State CIF for final selection.
- Nominations and/or votes for CCS recipients of the **CIF Model Coach Award** other than as described above will not be entertained.
- After tallying all votes received by the designated deadline, the CCS Office will notify all nominees of what names will be forwarded on to the State CIF Office. The State CIF will select and recognize all state-wide **CIF Model Coach Award** winners at a time and place deemed most appropriate by the State CIF.
